What to Expect This Year

HG&E is committed to providing competitive rates, reliable service, and excellent customer service. As a municipal utility, we have the ability to make decisions based on the needs of our ratepayers and the community, but we must comply with federal and state regulations and mandates. While many expenses fall outside our direct control, HG&E is committed to managing costs in the most efficient and sustainable ways, while maintaining reliable, safe service for customers.

In order to keep pace with the rising cost of delivering service, HG&E recently adjusted several electric and natural gas rates. These adjustments will increase the cost for residential gas customers by an average of \$3.57 per month (2.79%) and increase the cost for residential electric customer by an average of \$1.65 per month (2.51%).
